<p><b>Enrolment Criteria for Exchange Students</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum 42,0 ECTS per each Semester</li> <li>• Submission of “Changes to the Learning Agreement” only available until the 4<sup>th</sup> week of the starting day of classes. Changes only allowed once, without exceeding the enrolment limits.</li> <li>• Some of the optional subjects may have limited places/vacancies. We cannot guarantee availability for all students.</li> <li>• Optional subjects will be offered/lectured if the minimum number of enrolled students is met (10 students).</li> <li>• Schedules are usually only available near the starting day of each semester.</li> <li>• Courses from 1<sup>st</sup> Year/ 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle are <u>not advisable</u>.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Language Requirements</b></p>	<p><b>Main/Official teaching language is Portuguese.</b></p> <p>However, a minimum of English knowledge is also necessary, because some of the study materials and other relevant information may be available/provided by the Professors in this language.</p> <p>No Portuguese language certification is requested for the application.</p>
<p><b>Educational language for Exchange Students</b></p>	<p>Students can enroll in a beginner’s Portuguese Language Course offered by ICLP, also from the University of Lisbon, The course costs around 75€ and has a duration of 50 hours (6ECTS). Nominated students will be informed by email when the application period is open. The course has limited vacancies.</p>
