

"LANGUAGE & CULTURE" SUMMER COURSE

What is it?

Intensive French language training supplemented by a range of educational and cultural activities.

When and where is it?

In Montpellier, one of the most attractive cities in the South of France, **from July 1st to August 29th 2016** (to be confirmed).

The 'Language&Culture' Summer School takes place in July and August. Depending on your level, it is possible to register for two months, just for the July course (**July 1st to 29th**) or just for the August course (**August 1st to 29th**).

Who is it for?

The Summer School is designed for international students and graduates, having a French level from absolute beginner to intermediate (from A0 to B1).

What is it for?

- To prepare non-native students to attend a French Engineering Diploma and Master's Degree course or a PhD in France by giving them daily practice of oral and written language, essential to succeed in course work.
- To offer international students a language training in French as a Foreign Language aiming to gain cultural knowledge and to facilitate a successful integration.



What is in the programme?

- 100 hours of French language teaching per month
- 50 hours of cultural activities per month
- A refresher course in French for lower-level students

Upon arrival, students take a placement test in order to be placed in the most appropriate group according to level. The maximum group size is 15 students per class, with an average of 12.

Outside the classroom, students participate in organized activities designed to help enhance language skills through immersion in French cultural events.

Example of outdoor activities organized in summer 2015:

Visit of Nîmes and Pont du Gard, visit of the Cité of Carcassonne medieval castle, visit of Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert which is ranked as one of the most beautiful villages in France, visit of a vineyard and a wine tasting...

At the end of the training, students can supplement their qualification in French with a TFI or BULATS certificate, recognised world-wide by employers and educators (on request, fee-paying).

ECTS credits: in progress.

Where to stay?

Students are accommodated in the SupAgro halls of residence located a 3-minute walk away, across the road from the campus.

What are the monthly rates?

Rental rates vary depending on room size. Range:

- 293*€ - 324*€ for a single studio or
404*€ - 431*€ for a double studio (limited in number) in the residence hall « CIGALES ».
- 378*€ for a single studio in the residence hall « HAMEAUX ».
- 295*€ - 468*€ for a single studio or
483*€ - 526*€ for a double studio (limited in number) in the residence hall « SOLEIL ».

The canteen is situated on the Montpellier SupAgro La Gaillarde campus. It provides a catering service from Monday to Friday from 11:30am to 1:30pm. The price of a meal was 3€60 in 2015.

How much does it cost?

- The participation fee is 860*€ per month for the whole programme (including French classes and cultural programme)
- The participation fee is 680*€ per month for French classes only.
